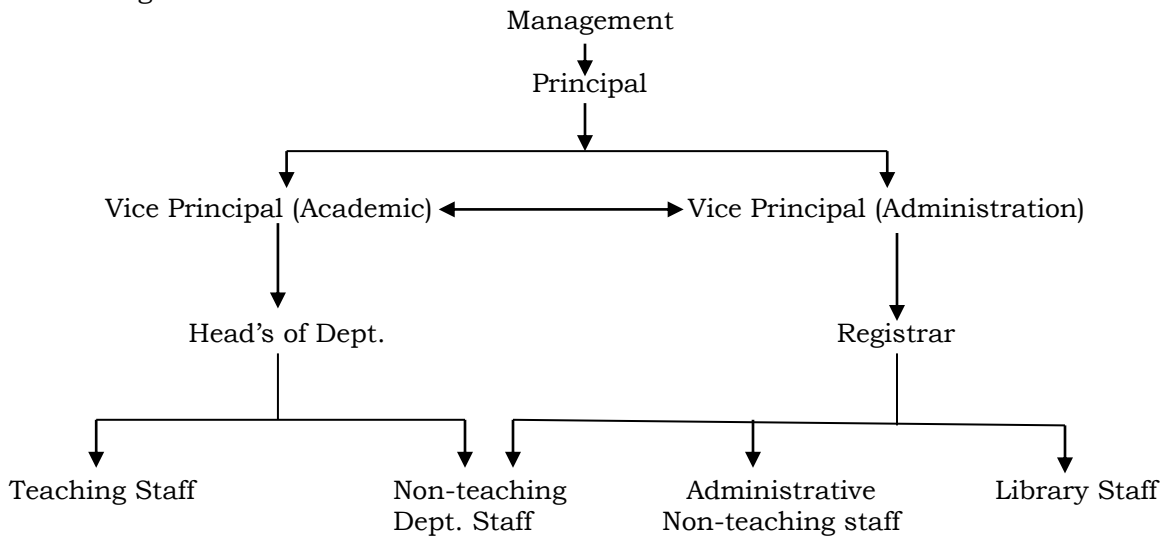

As per the University guidelines, the college has a Women Development Cell (WDC), formed to look after women (female staff and students) grievances, if any. 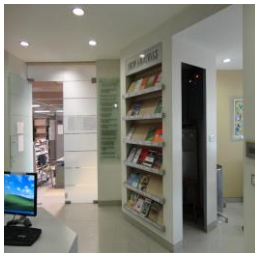
