## **Counselling Round VI (Vacancy Round-II)**

**(F.E. Admissions 2019-20)**

**(Open & GCLM Categories)**

Aspiring Candidates, who have applied to this college are hereby informed that there will a Counselling Round (Vacancy Round-II) on the 14<sup>th</sup> of August 2019.

***Please Note:- After closing the seats in branches, such as Computer Engineering and Information Technology during the Counselling Round V (Vacancy Round-I) on 13<sup>th</sup> August 2019, there have been few vacancies in these branches. These seats as well as other vacancies being created in all other branches on 14<sup>th</sup> August 2019 will all be taken up during this round.***

The internal vacancies arising out of cancellations (due to upward movement), if any, during the round will also be filled in this round itself.

The exact schedule to be followed in this vacancy round is as follows:

Candidates are advised to keep all the documents ready (originals + two photocopies) along with the Demand Draft /Pay Order of Rs. 1,82,864/- drawn in favour of “**Dwarkadas J Sanghvi College of Engineering**”, while reporting for the admission.

Candidates, who have completed their 12<sup>th</sup> standard from a board other than Maharashtra state board will have to produce an additional Demand Draft/ Pay Order of Rs. 1,320/- drawn in favour of “**Dwarkadas J Sanghvi College of Engineering**” for the purpose of verification process for obtaining the eligibility from the University of Mumbai.

Please note that the list of relevant documents required for securing admission has been put up on the college website. You may note that the DD & the list of documents are to be made compulsorily available at the time of admission, without which the admission will not be offered.

Candidates will be called as per the merit order and if at that time, they do not possess the requested documents and the D.D./Pay Order, that particular seat will be offered to the next eligible candidate on the spot. Candidates are requested to promptly produce the required documents & the DD as applicable at the time of their admission.

**Please Note :-** Candidates, who have already secured admission in the previous round (ILS or Vacancy Round) and wishes to upgrade their branch in this Vacancy Round (subject to availability of vacancy) are required to bring the original Fee Receipt (issued in previous round) as well as a demand draft of Rs.1000/- (transfer fee) at the time of admission.

**Candidates, who are from OBC, EBC, SEBC, VJ, NT, SBC, SC, ST and TFWS categories etc. and have already secured admission through any of the CAP rounds and wishes to upgrade their branch in this Vacancy Round (subject to availability of vacancy) are required to bring a Demand Draft of the amount (Rs. 1,82,864/- minus the amount already paid by the student) and another Demand Draft of Rs.1000/- (transfer fee) at the time of admission.**

Candidates are clearly advised to note that the seat will be allotted to them, only in case a vacant seat is available as and when their turn comes. If the seats are already filled up, by the time the turn of the candidate comes in the order of merit, they will have to wait for further vacancies, if any, in the next round.

**Please Note:- Candidates are compulsorily required to be present at the time of admissions, failing which the admission may not be offered.**

All are requested to keep checking the college website for more information on a continuous basis.
