Trinity came up with Interdepartmental debate competition as a pathway to fulfil its goals of enlightening and intellectually uplifting the morals of one and many.

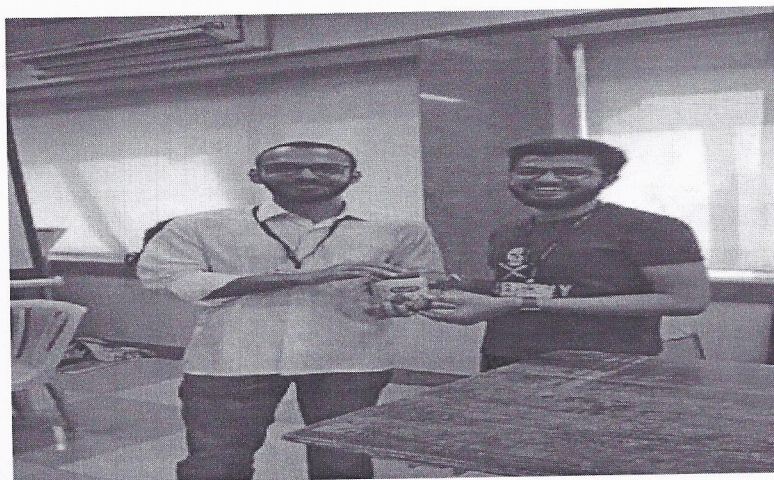
